




# The Radial Adjustment Brush added in LR5

“Radial Adjustment Brush” in Develop Module


Most of the Develop Module adjustments are available.

Feather defines the amount of blending. The default of 50 is usually good; sometimes need to adjust.

All adjustments are made inside or outside the area selected.

Inside: Invert mask checked

Outside: Invert mask unchecked
