

# Judge raves about 'absolutely awesome photograph'

Wow! This image is a clear winner. An absolutely awesome photograph. Very entertaining, very artistic, very creative. A real work of art. The gears in the eyes match the gears in the head.

This is one of those images that you can hang on the wall and people would just go "wow... this is really cool!" I just cannot stop looking at this image. The hairlight on the top of the hair with the rimlight going around the hair - this is really professionally done. The direction of the light from left to right with a slight shadow on the right side of the face and right side of the apple is good. Good lighting, great composition, great creativity, great artistry... all comes together perfectly for me.

One little thing I would have changed - I would have put the catchlight away from the center of the eye and more to the left which would match more the light on the face. If the catchlight would be off to the side I would have given this image a perfect score: 15 points.


- Your camera selections and settings




# **Sharpening tips offered**

Our April meeting judge, Tim Ostermeyer, shared his favorite sharpening technique. Here it is:

- Make a Duplicate Layer
- Go Filter > Other > High Pass
- Set Radius: 2 to 10 (make it look gray with contours popping out of the gray)
- Zoom into Image
- Go to Layer Palette > Select Hard Light from Left Drop Down
- Go to Opacity Slider and Select a Level of Sharpening (20 to 70%)
