


### BEST OF SHOW: WINNER - SYDNEY MARATHON 2010 - WHEELCHAIR DIVISION - BY RUSSELL MCGUIRE

The shot was taken at the end of the Sydney Marathon on 19th September, 2010 with a Canon EOS 30D at 1/200 at f10 on ISO 100. Lens was at 24 mm. This participant was surrounded by four cyclists to ensure there were no accidents with the runners who shared the same course. The location for the image was about 300 feet before the end of the race that finished up the steps of the Sydney Opera House.

Most of the images I shot that day were taken with a fast shutter speed. However the subject lent itself to a panning shot. I wanted the background to be recognizable, so I used a moderate shutter speed (1/200) and panned quickly. This was the second place participant, as it took me a few shots to capture the image I wanted.

Post-processing consisted of converting to black and white (some of the colors worn by the spectators were garish and distracting), cropped slightly, applied a vignette, and a few adjustments to contrast exposure. No Digital Blurring.



### Panoramic Print Competition Rules

The board has decided to update and clarify the rules concerning the Panoramic Print Competition in March, 2011. The rules state that the actual image must have an aspect ratio of at least 2 to 1 or greater and must be at least 96 square inches. This allows for a 14 x 7 inch image. The maximum size of the mat or mounting board (if un-matted) is  $16 \times 24$ .

The image may be in horizontal or vertical format. The image may be stitched from multiple images or cropped from a larger image.



#### GUEST SPEAKER: ELEANORE AVERY —*IMAGES OF BHUTAN*

Eleanore Avery FDCC, APSA, lives in Dallas, but does much of her photography while traveling the world. Her interest in photography grew as she began to travel extensively visiting about 65 countries since 1985. In addition to hundreds of awards at local, national and international levels, her travel photographs have received recognition in *PhotoGraphic, Popular Photography* and *Natures Best Photography* magazines. Several travel/photo articles have been published, including Africa, Singapore, Malaysia, Austria, China, and Norway in ITN travel publication.

She has presented lectures on digital photography, and presents about 15 digital slide shows each year at senior, travel and camera clubs. She is an active member of the Dallas Camera Club, Plano Photography Club, PSA (Photographic Society of America). She is PSA Region 24 Director and President of GSCCC (Gulf States Camera Clubs Council).

Eleanore awards include: Photographer of the Year, Slide of the Year at both Plano and Dallas Camera Clubs, Color and Monochrome Prints of the Year, Creative Portraits, and Travel Photo Competitions. She received Fellow award of Dallas Club (FDCC). She has received the "Best of Show" award in Heard National Nature Contest, twice received "Best of Show" at PSA International Wildlife Exhibition and has presented digital shows most years since 2004 at the annual PSA International Conferences.



## Message from the President: *Don't Shoot Yourself in the Foot!*

When choosing images for a competition, there is a fine line between being true to your artistic style and pandering to the judges. I can't tell you which images to choose, but here are some things to consider when making a selection. You want to make a good first impression and you can start by avoiding the Judge's Red Flags:

- Don't choose an image simply because it has a fond memory for you.
- Don't put a border around your digital image.
- Don't have crooked horizons or buildings.
- Don't have blown out areas in the sky or the subject.
- Don't have your subject out of focus.

Not all judges care about these points, but more do care than don't care. So, don't shoot yourself in the foot!
