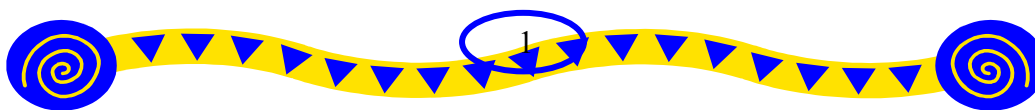

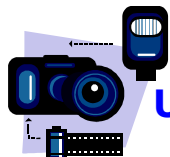

## BEST OF SHOW: *FISHING EAGLE* - BY RON HASTY

This image was taken in March in southeast Alaska on a really cold day. I was in a chartered water taxi that had a bow that could be lowered to the water level so that I could lay flat and be at water level as the eagle completed its dive. When an eagle left its perch in the trees I would begin to track it. When the eagle started a dive, I started a burst, hoping to get just the right composition and exposure. I was using a Nikon D 700 with a 70-200 zoom lens and a 1.4 extender set at F 5.6. Shutter speed was 1250 with an ISO of 400, spot metering and spot focus.

### CHANGES TO SCORING

The board has made some changes to the Competition scoring. In addition to Place points for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup>, one Place Point will be given for Honorable Mention.

Also, the End-of-Year awards for best photographer in the Beginner, Advanced and Masters classes will be based on Place Points plus Judge's Points. The Competition Standings table in the newsletter will be sorted in this order. The Photographer of the Year will continue to be based solely on Judge's Points.

The change for Honorable Mention is retroactive to the May Competition.

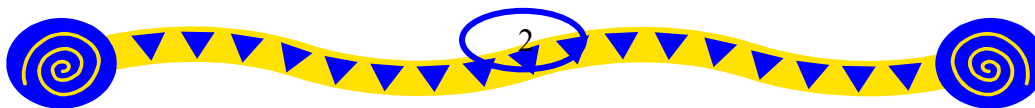
We are continuing to refine the commentary process during the presentation of Competition Results at the monthly meeting. More details later.

## **GUEST SPEAKER – *CREATING ART FROM YOUR IMAGES* – RON MARABITO**

This program explores some of the hundreds of possibilities that are available to you the photographer for producing art from your images. This program concentrates on changing photographic images to art within Photoshop and does not include any composite images or use of other programs.

Ron will take you step by step through the conversion. You should be able to use this information immediately to produce your own art creations. Come join us for a real learning experience that will increase your joy of photography.

Born in Alliance in 1932 and raised in Cleveland, Ohio, Ron was determined to relocate to some warmer weather. In 1950, prior to the Korean War, he joined the Air Force, found his way to Texas and eventually married.

After a degree in Architecture at the University of Texas at Austin, Ron settled in Dallas with his family and began his internship. He also headed the Construction Management & Technology Department at Richland College, was a General Contractor from 1978-85 and a licensed Interior Designer since the '90s. Ron is now retired, preferring to travel by motor home around North America enjoying his art and photography.

Ron first photographed his travels, starting in the '60s, to be able to relive the travel experiences. Later his photography became more important, an art form he came to love. Ron also worked with mixed media art. He decided to exhibit his photography in the early '80s. In 1986, he combined his talents developing his unique expression of photographic art later known as "Photo Escapes". What led to this expression was a firm belief that most people cannot see outside the frame of a photo or piece of art. By artistically duplicating portions of the photographic image on the mat, Ron guides the viewer beyond the edges and allows the viewer to complete the picture with their imagination. Thus, "Photo Escapes".

In addition to his unique mixed media work and computer generated art, he produces digital floral, landscape, nature and architectural photographic images. Ron heads up the Field Trips for the Heard Nature Photographers and has done so for the Plano Photography Club in the past. He has won the "Members Choice Award" at the Heard for three consecutive years.

## **TABLETOP WORKSHOP**

The TableTop Workshop is a fun tradition of the Plano Photography Club that encourages creativity and experimentation in your photography. Unique setups using special lighting and props are set on tables to inspire you to experiment with composition, exposure, and focus. While the workshop is part of our training efforts, it is fun for all our members and often results in winning photos for our monthly contests.

Attendees are encouraged to volunteer as monitors for the various stations. This is a wonderful opportunity to learn even more as you become the "instructor." (We teach you what you need to know.) You'll still have time to try out the other stations. Come enjoy this "cool" indoor photo shoot.

Officers meet at 7 p.m. on the second Monday of each month (except December) at a *location to be announced*. Open to all members.

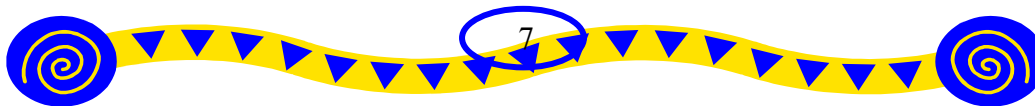
