
Best in Show: Guitar - By Linda Lee Bickford

There are many amazing photographs entered each month so I am honored my photograph won "Best of Show" this month. I learn so much from seeing and listening to the comments of all the photographs entered and how to improve my work. I value being a member of PPC. This club offers so much in the way of learning and everyone freely shares information to help each other and the workshops are enlightening. There has never been a meeting or event that I have not learned something new.

When I take pictures for graduating seniors I like to have them bring something they are interested in so I can incorporate their interest within their photographs for their graduation. This is one such photograph.

This photograph was shot with studio lighting and a Canon Mark II and Canon 24-105 lens which allowed me to pull the shot in. Using manual setting and f5.6 with ISO 200. The original shot was good but just did not pop, so I played with different angles and effects in Lightroom and came up with this one. This effect strengthens the edges creating a sharp photograph with vivid colors.

Lepp's images have appeared in some of the world's most widely viewed venues and on the covers of many books and magazines, including Natural History, Car and Driver, PC Photo, and Outdoor Photographer; at prestigious galleries and museums throughout the United States; and at the corporate headquarters of Canon USA, Eastman Kodak, and Epson America.

The program will once again be held at the Fort Worth Botanic Gardens, Dorothea Leonhardt Lecture Hall beginning promptly at 9:00 AM and running until 3:00 PM. Fall Outdoor Model Shoot

The Plano Photography Club will hold its Fall Outdoor Model Shoot on Saturday, September 29 from 10 AM to 3 PM. We will use the outdoor facilities of Hidden Cove Park located in The Colony, Texas. The park has the usual city park amenities, but what makes this one different is that it is located right on Lake Lewisville and has lots of wooded areas to shoot. Additionally, there are small shelters and pavilions available to the park's guests. There are grassy shores, rocky shores, and sandy shores that can all be used for your photography.

Within view, on the opposite shoreline is the Hidden Cove Marina, very near to where we will be shooting. There are also several spots where you can photograph a model with large areas of water in the background, or sections of the beach with green grass and trees in the background. There are modest yet modern restroom facilities.

The PPC event fee includes a light lunch/snacks, model fees and rental of a small cabin to be used for the models dressing room. A tarp or a table will be provided on which to place equipment to keep it off the dusty ground. The fee does not include the \$10 vehicle entry fee into the park. To save a few dollars, participants can carpool and split the \$10 entry fee.

To participate, you must be a club member by the end of the August PPC monthly meeting. Sign-up for the event is at the August club meeting. The event fee (approximately \$24) is due at that time and is non-refundable.
