BEST IN SHOW: GIRL WITH HAT - BY VICTOR SHUNG

 $\chi$  am surprised and honored that my photograph won "Best in Show" this month. I have seen many of other photographs in this contest that were well deserved to win this title than mine. The image was taken at last year Fall Outdoor Model Shoot. Because of the weather, we moved the shooting to indoor at the church. I have to attribute most credit to The Plano Photography Club members who setup the perfect lighting and background for me to shoot this image.

The lighting was simple but very effective – a soft box flash was placed left of the camera at 45 degree angle and a fairly large white reflector stood at the opposite side as a fill. The background was made up by a group of multicolored balloons. I was using Canon 7D with a 24-105 zoom lens at F16, 1/250 sec. and ISO 100. I did a little cropping and adjusting the contrast, clarity and vibrancy in Camera Raw. I removed some skin blemishes and softened up the skin tone by Gaussian blur filter in Photoshop CS5.


