#### BEST IN SHOW: PARK & RIDE - BY DON CHAMPLIN


This image was captured about an hour after sunset at the Park & Ride

parking lot below George Bush Tollway at Ave K. I had scouted the location previously because it looked to have some potential and took several handheld shots from various locations looking for the best perspective with a 24-70mm lens. Most did not amount to much but this viewpoint had some interest.

 ${f \chi}$  returned the next week on Sunday afternoon, the only time when it is free

of cars in the lot, and took some shots with a 14mm lens on a tripod, which worked well. I post processed in black & white in order to enhance the sky and clouds. I knew it could be a better image and one Sunday night I went back at dusk and shot it again with a 17mm T/S lens to straighten up the lines and correct distortion. I lucked out and had the moon and Venus centered between the overpasses the day I took this image. I still think some improvement can be had by shooting earlier with a little brighter sky to bring the blue up and also move the camera back some to include some signs.

### **Guest Speaker –** *Composition, Creativity, and Constructed Images –* Priscilla Derr Killion

*M*y photography involves both creating and recording an image. The composition may begin with an idea, an object, or simply an experiment with some design element or technique. However, I am always interested in "things" - how we perceive the objects around us and the memories or meanings we attach to them.

 $\chi$  bought my first camera after earning my second college degree. First degree was in business (finance), the second in Visual Art. I intended to use that camera as a "sketch pad." The objects, scenes, or whatever I photographed were to be re-composed into painted artworks. However, new ideas for compositions kept coming faster than I could paint. So, I began putting together complete setups with the photograph as a final product. And instead of buying expensive studio gear, I usually built my own equipment or used items from the hardware store. Although I can now create many effects or setups with Photoshop, I still enjoy the challenge of building a complete composition in front of the camera lens.

t the Plano Photography Club Tabletop Workshops, I have shared some of my special effects setups. I assembled some setups into Technique Boxes with diagrams, instructions, and equipment. These boxes can be borrowed by members to create their own compositions. Because, as many fine artists (and photographers) already know, tabletop setups are excellent exercise for improving skills with camera, composition, creativity ... and getting a beautiful final image.
