*M*ike Mezeul II is a professional photographer based out of Allen, Texas. He has spent much of his career as a photographer capturing images for numerous publications and clients around Texas. His subject matter focuses primarily on advertising, lifestyle, professional sports and concerts.

capturing the beauty and power of the severe thunderstorms which wreak havoc to the area on a yearly basis. For the past 13 years, he has documented hundreds of storms, numerous tornadoes, and record breaking hail from as far south as the Texas/Mexico border, up to the Dakotas. He has faced life-threatening situations and driven into some of the world's most powerful storms, all for one shot. Through his images, he strives to bring his audience along for the ride and experience Mother Nature at her worst.

### Flash FUNdamentals Workshop

Come join us for this introduction to flash photography. We will teach you how to use your external flash (speedlight) to get the best possible pictures. Because this is a training session, there will be introductory training and there will be mentors to help you to get to know your own equipment and how to use it to its best advantage. We will be covering flash fundamentals, controlling your flash and creative flash modifiers.

Please bring your camera, external flash, extension cables, wireless trigger, manuals and someone or something to photograph. Here is a chance to practice your skills on a family member or friend.

The workshop will be held at Grace Presbyterian Church Education Building, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor from 10 AM to 1 PM. The instructional portion is from 10 AM to 10:30 AM. After that there will be one-on-one mentoring and practice sessions.
