This image was captured with a point-and-shoot camera! So, the most valuable thing to share about this is: "The best camera is the one you have with you." (A quote attributed to at least four different photographers—thanks for the reminder, Jim!) This is a picture of a ropes course on a cruise ship. I wanted to record this unusual opportunity, but didn't have time to fetch my "big rig" (DSLR).

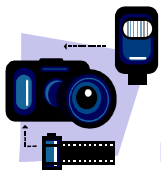
It was taken with a Nikon Coolpix S9700 (1/2000 sec., f 3.7, ISO 125) and edited in Lightroom, where I converted it to black and white, and encouraged it to become more of a silhouette. I cropped, cloned out distracting bits, and enhanced the contrast in the clouds.

Wish I could offer something more interesting or inspiring, but bottom line, this reminds us of two important things: you can't take the moment home if you don't press a button on something! And, the value of good editing software to get the image closer to what you saw—closer to what inspired you to press that button in the first place!

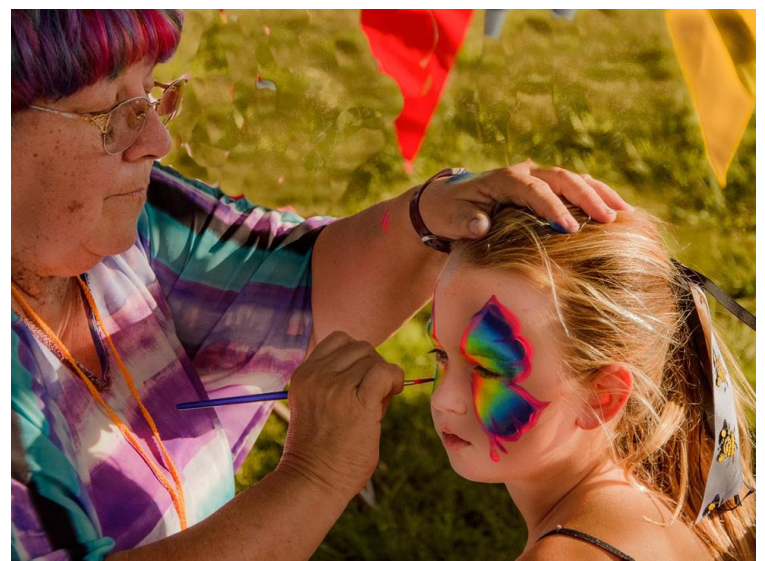

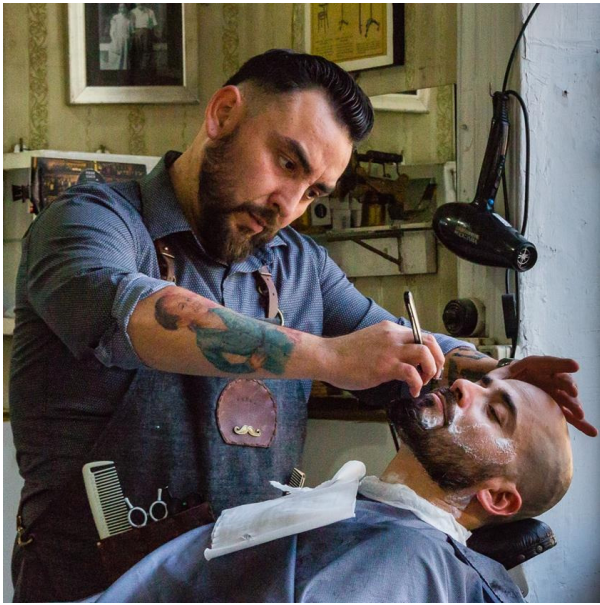

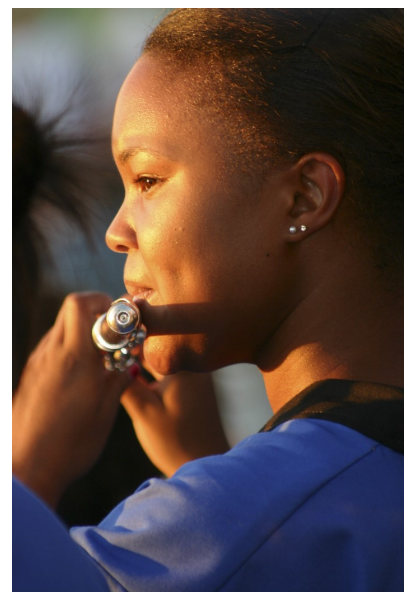
