

## **Best In Show: Traveling By John Lehman**

I may be crazy but I have always loved dandelions when they go to seed. I think the first one I remember entering into a contest was 30 years ago. This dandelion came from our lawn (we had lots to choose from).

I approach everything like a portrait photographer. I see this dandelion as a portrait as well and I work the lighting as I would a portrait. In the winter I had already set up a small studio in a north facing window to do some still life photography. I set up some black velvet. I use a weighted clamp from Michael's that is used for folks who do beads. It's a great way to hold a flower in position. I utilized LED lighting with diffusers to get the light the way I wanted it. In some days, I shot with just natural light. I shoot with a Fuji XT2 on a tripod and shot with an extension tube on my 18-135 zoom at 34 mm, F 18, 1.5 second exposure. Post processing was cropping and basic processing in LR and then I used On1 Effects for the B&W effects. I present a lot of B&W because it focuses on textures, details, etc. and removes the distraction of color.

## **FLASHback: The Age Of Digital**

May, 2006 was a memorable date for the Plano Photography Club with the introduction of digital images in the monthly competition. Prior to that date, each member could submit two images, any combination of prints and slides.

By 2006 many members had started the conversion to digital photography and the number of slides submitted each month decreased dramatically. So slides were dropped in favor of digital images.

Digital images became very popular, and with the time and expense involved in making print, the number of print submissions declined. So in May 2007, the board decided to dedicate two of the competitions to prints and nine to digital.

Eventually as the club grew the number of submissions soared and we were forced to cut back to one image per competition.

Today we have eight digital competitions and two print. In April we have a special competition that does not count toward standings.

## Photographic Society Of America Conference

This year's Photographic Society of America's 2017 International Conference of Photography is in Philadelphia PA October 8-14. It is jam packed with exciting programs, world-class speakers, Division presentations, photo workshops, and 13 photographic tours. Included are a riverboat cruise and visits to Frank Lloyd Wright's Fallingwater, an abandoned steel mill, Phipps Conservatory, and more.

Programs include showing of the Pictorial Print, Photo Travel, Photojournalism, Projected Image and Nature International Exhibitions. The very popular Model Shoot will be expanded into two classroom sessions and two days of model shoots. Conference speakers include: Adam Jones, Rob Knight, Joe McDonald, Frank T. Smith, and Nancy Wolff.

## Milton H. Greene: "Women"

The Arlington Museum of Art presents an exhibition of photographs by Milton H. Greene through August 6, 2017. See http://arlingtonmuseum.org

Born in New York in 1922, Milton Greene began taking pictures at the early age of 14. Although he was the recipient of a scholarship to the renowned Pratt Institute, a heightened awareness of the photographic image diverted his attention to the camera and its versatility. He soon apprenticed himself to the famous photojournalist and wizard of composition, Elliot Elisofen. Before long, his keen regard for fashion and the camera found him assisting Louise Dahl-Wolfe, the distinguished fashion photographer known for her unique covers and fashion pages for Harper's Bazaar.

The range of Milton Greene's subjects include such people as Marilyn Monroe, Audrey Hepburn, Frank Sinatra, Elizabeth Taylor, Ava Gardner, Marlene Dietrich, Grace Kelly, Cary Grant, Sammy Davis Jr., Sir Lawrence Olivier, Judy Garland, Paul Newman, Dizzy Gillespie, and Catherine Deneuve as well as many others. But it was his unique friendship, business relationship and ensuing photographs of Marilyn Monroe for which he is most remembered.

## Guest Speakers – "A Photographic Memory Of Antarctica" – Carol Barlow

Traveling is life to me; a year without travel makes me restless and even despondent. My father instilled this yearning in me through yearly road trips across the US. By the time I was 17 I had been to 49 states and over 30 national parks. After our marriage, Bruce and I returned to many of these places and began to add international travel. I set my goal to visit all the continents thinking Antarctica was a remote dream. As it turns out, Australia is the continent I lack.

Another interest my father passed on was photography, and I received my first camera when I was eight. My snapshots didn't

measure up to the beauty I beheld, so in 2001 I joined the Plano Photography Club for the purpose of taking better photos of my travels. I am learning you have to "make" photos, not "take" them, and how to compensate for the lessthan-ideal conditions of my style of travel.

While making many friends in the club, I have been honored to serve as Publicity Chair, Training Chair, and President. Knowing that many in the club enjoy travel, my hope is that I can share some helpful tips for travel photography and the joy of the discovery of the "Last Continent."
