

Best In Show: Fall Colors Embrace Time Weathered Headstones By Daniel Dailey

This photo of tombstones was taken in November 2017 at the Greenwood Cemetery in Dallas. We had been shooting photos of the Old Cavalry Hill Cemetery and as it began to get close to closing time for the cemetery, we walked across North Hill Street to the Greenwood Cemetery, which had already closed. I walked along North Hill Street and started shooting photos through the wrought iron fence surrounding the cemetery. The grass was high and dry in many places and as I walked along the edge of the cemetery I noticed several spots where the grass became a lush green and autumn colors of the trees seemed to encompass the time weathered headstones. This was one of those spots. Details: Nikon D5500, Nikkor 18-55mm kit lens at 55mm, 1/640, f/5.8, ISO 1000. Post processing in Lightroom.

Big Changes For The Club

Last year the Board has announced that began with the 2017-2018 club year, there will be no April competition. The contest year will run from May through March and consist of 10 competitions instead of 11. The annual awards dinner will coincide with the regular May 17, 2018 meeting instead of a separate awards dinner in June.

For 2017-2018 club year, There will be two special end of year awards:

Portrait Award
Photojournalism Award

Any member can submit up to three entries in each special award category. Digital submissions are due at the April, 2018 meeting. An overall winner in each category will receive the award and a plaque. The next two entries will receive second and third place rosette ribbons. The results of these special awards are not considered in the high points, image of the year, or photographer of the year competitions. Members may propose and sponsor additional awards and provide the accompanying plaques and ribbons.

Promotions for the club competition are effective with the May competition. Members will be notified of their new competition class. Remember, promotion to Masters Class is based on the member's portfolio of work, both depth and breath, over several years, service to the club, and a demonstrated ability to teach and assist other club members. One of the best way to provide service is to volunteer to be a club officer. We encourage all members to volunteer to help make **your** club better.

As you know, our membership year runs from 1-May to 30-April. Many of you may be familiar with our competition web-site. In the past that site has been used only for managing the monthly photo competitions. As we have been preparing for the membership renewal process we looked into the features of the "competition web-site" and found that it was actually designed to be a complete system for managing a photo club. With that in mind, this year we are going to utilize that web-site for our membership renewal and on-going membership management. This web-site will now be considered our "Members Only" web-site. This will give each member full control and ownership of their contact information for PPC.

You can access the Members Only web-site by clicking on the Members Only menu button in the upper right corner of our primary web-site www.planophotographyclub.com. Or you can go directly to plano.photoclubservices.com.

You will still pay your dues by either check or cash at a club meeting and sign the Agreement of Waiver of Liability form. We are looking into the possibility of accepting PayPal transactions for the membership dues. But that is not in place yet. In either case, we still need everyone to sign the Agreement of Waiver of Liability form.

The annual fee that our club pays for the Members Only web-site service is determined by the number of Competing Members. We can have an unlimited number of non-competing members. Our current service agreement allows up to 100 competing members. We currently have 81 Competing Members.

As we transition to online membership we look forward to entering the 21st. Century!


