Special Note: July Meeting To Be Held August 2nd

Best In Show: Feeding Her - Courting Behavior By Ron Hasty

In April of 2018 we were joined by photography friends from New Jersey for a "Texas Photo Safari." We planned the trip to include stops in Ennis for the Bluebonnets, the hill country for wildflowers, wildlife and starry skies and then the Rio Grande valley for birds and wildlife. We spent 6 days in the valley photographing several dozen species.

It was a great time of the year to see birds in their breeding plumage and exhibiting courting behavior. In the spring the male Northern Cardinal behaves territoriality and stakes out his territory with song, which he hopes will attract a female. During courtship, the male feeds seed to the female beak-to-beak as you see in this image. He will also feed the fledglings for a short time after they leave the nest. Photographing this quick moment requires patience and persistence. Trying to catch them in an environment which makes a good setting for a picture adds complexity to the situation.

Details: Nikon D500, Sigma 150-600 @420 mm, F/6.3, 1/1250, ISO 2000, manual mode, spot metering and spot focus.

July 21, 2018 – **Mesquite Rodeo** – Join us at the Mesquite Rodeo Saturday, July 21st for some action and motion photography. You may bring your tripod or mono-pod if you like but seating space is limited, so a mono-pod might be ideal. We have blocked 37 VIP seats (20 in section 5 and 17 in section 7) near the bucking chutes; roping will be coming from the opposite side and usually ends up in the center of the arena.

The group discount pricing is \$23 per VIP seat (\$38 regular price). Doors open at 6pm, show starts at 7:30 and all you can eat BBQ for additional \$20 per person is available before the show; parking is \$10. It's an indoor air conditioned arena located at 1818 Rodeo Drive, Mesquite, TX 75149.

For those that are interested, Brother Van, with Mesquite Rodeo, will take us in a group of 10 to 12 to the area behind the bucking chutes; I have been told, there are few steep steps to climb back there, so keep that in mind.

I purchase our seats only; you may purchase dinner there. I am placing a deposit to hold the seats and later paying the balance for the group a week before the event. Developing a Critical Approach to Looking at Photographs with Larry Petterborg. This new class will begin on August 16. The class will be open to all but is an on-going curriculum.

This Course is Designed to Help Students:

- 1) Critically look at and think about photographs,
- 2) To articulate their responses to the photographs viewed, and
- 3) To understand that judging a club photo contest is primarily a quantitative (scoring, ranking etc.) process the differs substantially from the qualitative nature of art criticism.

It is hoped that students will be able to develop critical analytical skills that contribute to improvements in the photographs they subsequently make.


