


Best In Show: Ranucula Bouquet - By Nancy Mack

I am trying new challenges! The Plano Photo Club has nurtured my skills, since I only picked up a camera for the first time four years ago. I would like to thank Bud Mallar for the study group: *This is a Camera*. You taught me the mystery of the exposure triangle and forced me to take pictures of anything but flowers. Gratitude to Ron Hasty for the *Printing Study Group*. The difference between seeing an image on screen and on a variety of media was invaluable to me as I evaluated my images. Larry Petterborg's *Special Projects Study Group* gave me the courage to approach a gallery. My floral images are on display in a group show. See below. This particular image is printed on a 30x20 metal plate with gloss finish.

The photo was made with a Nikon 7100 and a Nikon 105mm 2.8 macro lens, ISO 100, f5.6, 2.5 sec mounted on a tripod and tethered to a laptop running Helicon Remote. The flowers are from a grocery florist. Most of my floral images have a dark and moody feel, inspired by Old Master paintings. The background is a drape of black velvet lit by filtered light from a bay window. I exposed 16 images which were stacked in Helicon Focus: www.heliconsoft.com. The final image was imported into Lightroom and processed so that the black background became darker and richer in tone. The photo was then processed in Photoshop with the Topaz Clarity filter.

Developing a Critical Approach to Looking at Photographs with Larry Petterborg. This new class will begin on August 16. The class will be open to all but is an on-going curriculum.

This Course is Designed to Help Students:

- 1) Critically look at and think about photographs,
- 2) To articulate their responses to the photographs viewed, and
- 3) To understand that judging a club photo contest is primarily a quantitative (scoring, ranking etc.) process the differs substantially from the qualitative nature of art criticism.

It is hoped that students will be able to develop critical analytical skills that contribute to improvements in the photographs they subsequently make.

Coming in the Fall

Dr. John will hold a model shoot in the fall! He along with other experienced PPC members will provide instruction and then we will have several models available at several locations. This has always been a fun and educational experience. Details are being planned. Stay Tuned!







National Geographic photographer Tom Peschak, in his article, "How the Ultimate Shark Photo Went Viral"* wrote "Instead of the scientist tracking the shark the shark is now tracking the scientist, which was much more compelling. <u>Sometimes the best images are not the ones we planned for.</u>" Couple this with what our own Sam Wilson wrote a couple of years back about giving a young child a camera and looking at the results.
